Where to next?

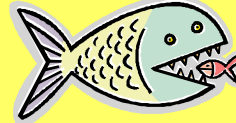

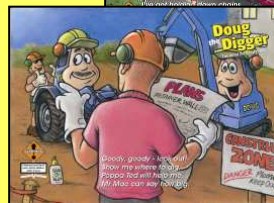
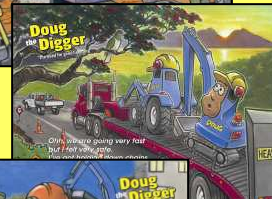
Competitions close....

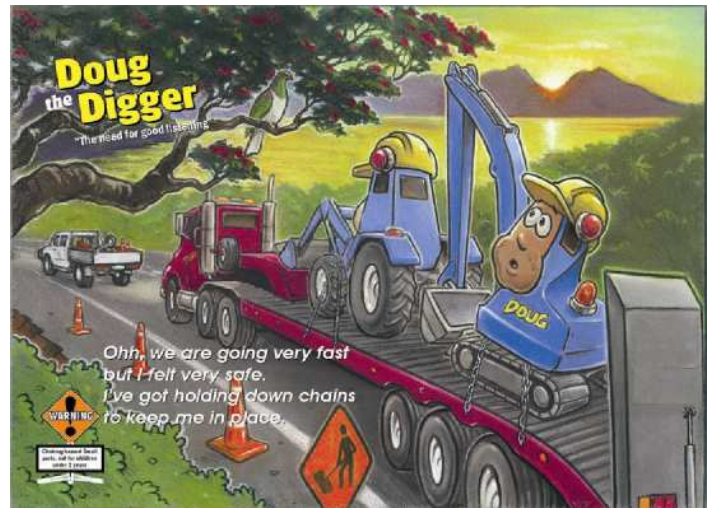
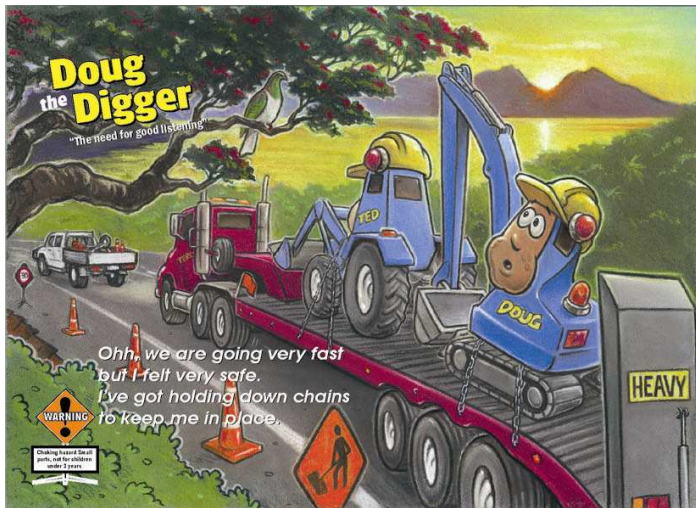
