This machine is a 1949 D8, 130HP, built in Peoria,

USA. This model was so popular 23,537 were manufactured between 1945 - 1953.

Lindsay purchased the D8 bulldozer off John Ewing (contractor) around 1990 as it had been sitting idle in the bush for many years.

This machine is now restored and proudly displayed in a work environment setting at New Zealand Caterpillar Experience in Rotorua.

The D8 bulldozer has 5 forward gears, a double drum Hyster winch, and was set up to run a scrub or bush roller off the side. A very popular machine for all types of bulldozing work.

I am the Owner/Director of a forestry contracting business which operates twelve large Caterpillar buildozers and excavators in the Central North Island.

We build and maintain forestry dirt roads for the logging trucks to drive in and pick up the logs that have been harvested.

The trucks take the logs to mills for processing or ports like Tauranga, to be exported to other countries around the world that can not grow enough trees of their own. We also clean-up the land so that new pine trees can be planted. This involves clearing logging slash, branches left from harvesting trees, removing stumps and rollercrushing scrub.

I have invented a special attachment for an excavator called a spot-cultivator. This tool rakes and rips very quickly through the soil and builds a mound for the new trees to be planted in.

Lindsay has been involved in many different area's of the forestry industry for about 30 years. As a hobby he collects old Caterpillar machines and restores them to working order. One day when you are visiting Rotorua, you may have time to visit them at his tourist attraction, NZ Caterpillar Experience.

We tell some interesting stories of how our land in New Zealand has been shaped by man and machinery, from the late 1800's when our country was covered in bush, through to how it looks today with farms and forests.

My future plans are to continue operating much the same as we do today and keep researching idea's for better productivity and creating the least amount of environmental damage.


