# Is the equipment safe to operate?

Lets check out a fire extinguisher.....

Mr Mac has three fire extinguishes; one in his truck cab, another in the trailer unit and the third is mounted on "Little Cutie" the Gough's Cat digger. Whilst visiting the schools in the Hawkes Bay region, Mr Mac had the opportunity to get all three fire extinguishers checked out to make sure they where they were all in SAFE correct operating order. Donna O'Connor and Russell Houghton of Fire Equipment H.B. carried out the safety checks. The photographs below illustrate some of the most IMPORTANT features of a fire extinguisher that need to be checked on a regular basis to ensure it will function correctly in the event of a fire.



## Green Zone...

The gauge on top of the fire extinguisher has a 'Green Zone.' If the indicator arrow has dropped below the 'Green Zone' the fire extinguisher needs to be refilled. The gauge also has a seal on it. If this seal is broken the fire

extinguisher needs to be checked out to make sure that it is in good working order.



The pin has to be unobstructed with no visible damage. The alignment of the pin and its bracket holder has to be precise.

The hose end has to be clear with no obstructions.

Here Cameron Smith of XT88 manufacturers is checking the wheel nuts, tyres tread depth, any loose wires and other visible defects as he cleans the truck.




