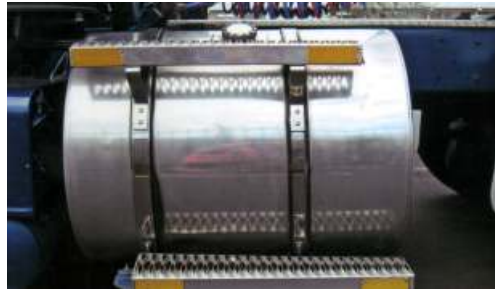


- Mr 'Mac' uses Caltex Diesel for fuel in his truck.

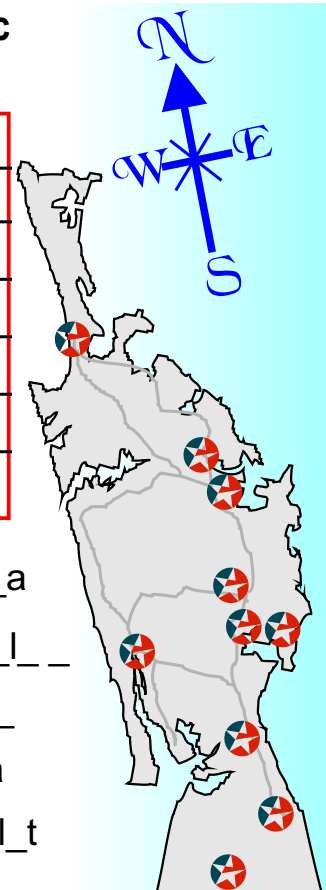

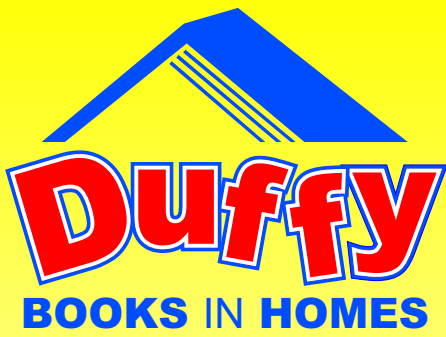


Name the locations of Caltex NDS Fuels Service Stations around Northland.

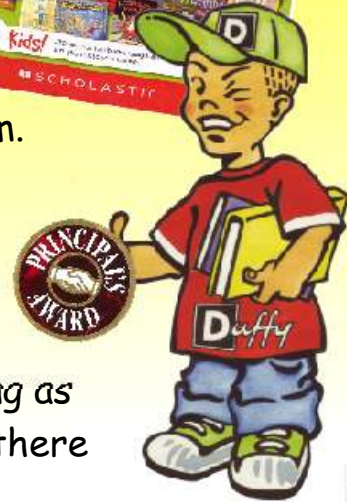

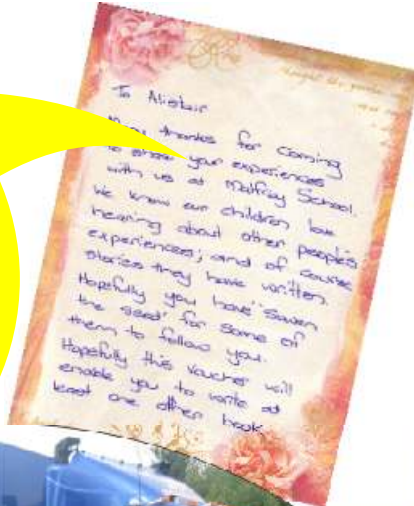
