How is the water collected?



Stormwater travels along the roadside kerb and channel


and into the cess pit...

Once the water has entered the site it goes through a "rocky outfall" separator.
This collects any unwanted rubbish such as bottle tops

The next stage the water passes through is called a "forebay" which acts as a settling pond for fine silt such as mud, sand and slush.
