Wetland Sanctuary

The concept is to develop unusable land and create a stormwater cleaning wetland nature reserve.

Environmental...

The area for the wetland sanctuary wasn't very environmentally eco friendly for the wildlife as it was covered in undesirable vegetation such as, gorse, toi toi, light scrub, weeds and a few ugly pine trees.



Pulverise...

To pulverise the undesirable vegetation into a workable mulch, a 160hp (118 kw) 4 wheel drive tractor with a heavy duty mulcher mower was used. This also made easy access so that the plan of the wetland could be laid out and marked on the ground.

Progress...

Progress is being made with different planning stages being implemented.

Ecological Study: What plants are here?
What wild life lives here?
What aquatic life lives here?

Restoration Plan: How was the project going to be carried out and who was involved from start to finish?

Management Plan: Step by step process. Earthworks, planting plan, and maintenance programmes.

Structures: Bridges, fords and paths.

Machinery...

A 22 tonne and a 9 tonne digger were used to strip and stock pile the mulch and topsoil layers.

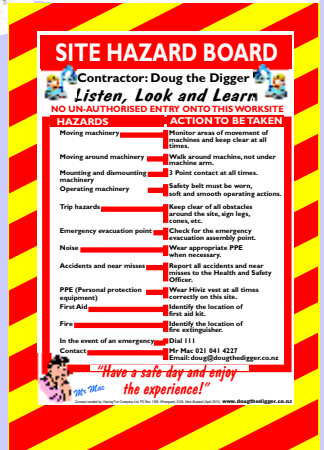

Time: 10.00 a.m – 4.00 p.m

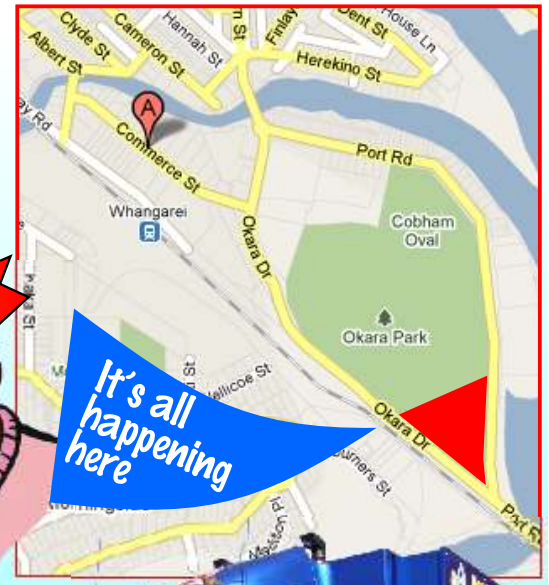
Entry by Gold Coin Donation – all proceeds go to local charities.
